Wardah Naeem Bukhari (b. 1988, Pakistan) is a visual artist, art educator, and independent curator with special interest in South Asian Textiles. Bukhari's art practice explores themes of history, craft, anthropology, culture, identity, and ecology through thread craft techniques on digital collage prints, videos, and sculptural installations. Apart from four solo exhibitions in Lahore, she has participated in around fifty-five exhibitions worldwide, including triennials and



biennales. "Women Situation and reinterpretation of Phulkari of Punjab" is the title of her latest digital collage series, which focusses on the phulkari of Punjab in her current research and artistic endeavors. She studied textiles and fabric art in her hometown of Multan for her PhD, and the topic of her dissertation was "Thread crafts of Multan in a cultural context." The rich history of thread crafts in Pakistan, such as the bride's Zardozi work on her wedding gown, the thread embellishment on Khussas, necklaces linked with pattoli skill, the ancient Paranda braid work, and hand-made embroidery, makes Multan a symbol of Pakistan. Her areas of interest in research are art therapy, South Asian contemporary art, craft, aesthetics, South Asian textiles and anthropology.
